Please find detailed below a summary of your request, together with our response.

**Summary of your request:**

***Please can you provide the number of attempted suicide/self harm admissions to the trust in the months outlined below:***

- (i) 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 to March 31<sup>st</sup> 2019***
- (ii) April 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 to Jun 30<sup>th</sup> 2019***

- (iii) 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 31<sup>st</sup>***
- (iv) April 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 to June 30<sup>th</sup> 2020***

***If possible can you provide a breakdown of age group; over 18, under 18.***

The Kent Community Health NHS Foundation Trust provides wide-ranging NHS care for people in the community, we would not have admissions for attempted suicide/self harm admissions; therefore we do not hold any information pertinent to your request.
