Thank you for your email received 21 October 2021 requesting information regarding the treatments for patients with major depressive disorders and other mental health conditions.

Please find detailed below a summary of your request, together with our response.

Summary of your original request:

Q1. How many patients have received the following treatments (for any condition) in the past 12 months:

- Electro-convulsive therapy (ECT)
- Esketamine nasal spray
- Ketamine infusion
- r-TMS therapy

Q2. For patients receiving electro-convulsive therapy in the past 12 months, how many patients were under treatment for:

- Major depressive disorder
- Other mental health conditions

Q3. How many patients with Major Depressive Disorder have been treated by your trust in the past 12 months?
