Thank you for your email received 8 November 2021 requesting information regarding registered deaths.

Please find detailed below a summary of your request, together with our response.

Summary of your original request:

1. The number of cases treated by the hospital per year and number of deaths registered per year for Measles for the years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021.

2. The number of cases treated by the hospital per year and number of deaths registered per year for Mumps for the years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021.

3. The number of cases treated by the hospital per year and number of deaths registered per year for Rubella for the years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021.

The Kent Community Health NHS Foundation Trust provides wide-ranging NHS care for people in the community, in a range of settings including people's own homes; nursing homes; health clinics; community hospitals; minor injury units and in mobile units.

We would not provide hospital treatment for the illnesses detailed in your request as our beds are rehabilitation beds; therefore we do not hold any information pertinent to your request.

The information you have requested would be held by the Acute Hospital Trusts.
