

Request for information under the Freedom of Information Act – 2022.160 Released - 20 September 2022

Thank you for your email received 13 September 2022 requesting information regarding out of hours GPs.

Please find detailed below a summary of your request, together with our response.

Summary of your original request:

- The number of occasions in the past 12 months when there were no out-of-hours GPs 1) on shift;
- What advice was given to patients who sought a GP during the period when none were available;
- What other staff were available during these occasions to provide assistance to patients;
- The number of patients who sought out of hours care while there were no GPs on duty in the past 12 months;
- The number of children who sought out of hours care while there were no GPs on duty in the past 12 months;
- The number of occasions when an out of hours centre was closed due to lack of staff in the past 12 months;
- The number of occasions when just one GP has been on duty for an out of hours shift in your area in the past 12 months

The Kent Community Health NHS Foundation Trust does not employ out of hours GPs; therefore we do not hold information for questions 1-7 of your request.
